**51% OF FLORIDA VOTERS SAY THEY WON'T VOTE FOR TRUMP,
QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS;
BIDEN IS MOST FAVORABLE DEM BY WIDE MARGIN**

A bare majority of Florida voters, 51 percent, say they definitely won't vote for President Donald Trump if he is the Republican candidate in the 2020 presidential race, according to a Quinnipiac University poll released today. Another 31 percent say they definitely would vote for the president and 14 percent say they would consider voting for him.

Definitely voting for President Trump are 75 percent of Republicans, 2 percent of Democrats and 21 percent of independent voters, the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University Poll finds.

Florida voters give Trump a negative 40 – 52 percent favorability rating.

Former Vice President Joseph Biden gets a positive 49 – 35 percent favorability rating, including 78 – 8 percent among Democrats and 46 – 28 percent among voters 18 to 34 years old.

Biden's favorability rating is way ahead of other Democratic contenders:

- Negative 37 – 49 percent for U.S. Sen. Bernie Sanders of Vermont, including a positive 61 – 26 percent among Democrats and a divided 38 – 40 percent among voters 18 to 34 years old;
- Negative 26 – 44 percent for U.S. Sen. Elizabeth Warren of Massachusetts, including a positive 54 – 16 percent among Democrats and negative 15 – 30 percent among voters 18 to 34 years old;
- Negative 23 – 30 percent for U.S. Sen. Kamala Harris of California;
- Negative 20 – 30 percent for U.S. Sen. Cory Booker of New Jersey.

The percentage of voters who haven't heard enough to form an opinion about each of the other candidates ranges from 56 percent to 90 percent.

“As he ponders a final decision on running for president, former Vice President Joseph Biden is getting some good news from the nation's most important voters,” said Peter A. Brown, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

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“Biden scores best by a mile when Florida voters are asked to rate their feelings about various Democratic presidential candidates,” Brown added.

“Florida voters have been the key to winning the Electoral College in several presidential elections. Biden has a healthy 49 – 35 percent favorability rating, the only potential candidate with more voters viewing him favorable than not. Senators Bernie Sanders and Elizabeth Warren are about as well-known as Biden, but they are both viewed negatively overall.

“And among younger less well-known aspirants, none has an overall positive rating.”

The possible candidates about whom Florida voters have not heard enough include:

- Former U.S. Rep. Beto O’Rourke of Texas – 56 percent haven’t heard enough;
- U.S. Sen. Kirsten Gillibrand of New York – 67 percent;
- U.S. Sen. Amy Klobuchar of Minnesota – 72 percent;
- Former Gov. John Hickenlooper of Colorado – 85 percent;
- Washington Gov. Jay Inslee – 90 percent.

President Trump’s Approval

With a big thumbs down from women, Florida voters give President Trump a negative 41 – 53 percent approval rating. Women give Trump a negative 35 – 59 percent approval rating. Men are tied 47 – 47 percent.

From March 6 – 11, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,058 Florida voters with a margin of error of +/- 3.7 percentage points, including the design effect.

The Quinnipiac University Poll, directed by Douglas Schwartz, Ph.D., conducts gold standard surveys using random digit dialing with live interviewers calling landlines and cell phones. The Quinnipiac University Poll conducts nationwide surveys and polls in more than a dozen states on national and statewide elections, as well as public policy issues.
