## CHRISTIE TRAILS CLINTON, BUT INCHES UP IN IOWA, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; VOTERS REJECT BERGDAHL POW SWAP

New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie is inching his way back into the 2016 presidential race in Iowa and now trails former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton 44 – 36 percent, according to a Quinnipiac University poll released today.

This compares to a 48-35 percent Clinton lead in a March 13 survey by the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University.

Secretary Clinton tops other possible Republican 2016 contenders:

- 46 40 percent over U.S. Sen. Rand Paul of Kentucky;
- 46 39 percent over former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee;
- 49 36 percent over former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush;
- 47 41 percent over U.S. Rep. Paul Ryan of Wisconsin.

Support for Clinton among Iowa's independent voters ranges from a too-close-to-call 42 percent for the Democrat to 38 percent for Ryan to a 47 – 30 percent Clinton lead over Bush.

Iowa voters give Clinton a 52-41 percent favorability, compared to 41-34 percent for Huckabee, divided scores of 34-32 percent for Paul, 35-35 percent for Ryan and 34-36 percent for Christie, and a negative 28-36 percent for Bush.

"Things are getting a bit better in Iowa for New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie," said Peter A. Brown, assistant director of the Quinnipiac Poll.

"But the Republican contender, who was ahead of Secretary of State Hillary Clinton in Iowa before 'Bridgegate' took him down several pegs, still has a ways to go.

"Secretary Clinton leads all the potential GOP candidates with U.S. Rep. Paul Ryan and Sen. Rand Paul running closest, six points in back of her."

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Iowa voters give President Barack Obama a negative 40-55 percent job approval rating, compared to a negative 39-57 percent score in a March 13 Quinnipiac University poll. Democrats approve 85-12 percent, while negative scores are 5-94 percent among Republicans and 33-59 percent among independent voters.

Men go negative 36 - 60 percent, with women negative 44 - 50 percent.

Voters approve 62 - 30 percent of the job U.S. Sen. Chuck Grassley is doing and give U.S. Sen. Tom Harkin a 56 - 33 percent approval.

"Iowans are consistent in their disapproval of President Barack Obama's job performance. In four polls over the past 11 months, his job approval has been between 38 percent and 41 percent, slightly below the numbers he is getting nationally," Brown said. "The key to his problem is he is doing poorly among independent voters, a larger part of the electorate in Iowa than in most states."

## **Bergdahl Prisoner Exchange**

Iowa voters disapprove 55 - 34 percent of the Obama Administration's decision to release five Taliban prisoners in exchange for Sgt. Bowe Bergdahl. Disapproval is 59 - 33 percent among men, 51 - 35 percent among women, 83 - 14 percent among Republicans, 56 - 29 percent among independent voters and among all age groups. Democrats approve 60 - 26 percent.

If it's found that Bergdahl deserted his post, Iowa voters say 74 - 13 percent that he should be charged with a military crime. There is strong support for charging the soldier among all party, gender and age groups.

"There is sharp partisan division about the wisdom of the prisoner swap, with Democrats strongly backing the president's decision and Republicans even more opposed. But there is smaller partisan split on the question of whether Sgt. Bergdahl should be prosecuted if it is proven that he deserted his post," said Brown.

From June 12 - 16, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,277 registered voters with a margin of error of  $\pm 2.7$  percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.
