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## TRUMP IS MOST LOVED – AND UNLOVED – IN IOWA GOP CAUCUS, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; WALKER FALLS FROM TOP SPOT TO NO. 10

Donald Trump has the support of 27 percent of Iowa likely Republican Caucus participants, with 21 percent for Ben Carson and 9 percent for U.S. Sen. Ted Cruz of Texas, according to a Quinnipiac University poll released today.

This compares to the results of a July 1 survey by the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University showing Wisconsin Gov. Scott Walker at 18 percent, with Trump and Carson at 10 percent each.

Today, Walker is at 3 percent, way behind in the pack. Former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush has 6 percent of Iowa likely Republican Caucus participants, with 5 percent each for Carly Fiorina, Ohio Gov. John Kasich and U.S. Sen. Marco Rubio of Florida. No other candidate tops 4 percent, with 4 percent undecided.

Trump also tops another list as 25 percent of Iowa likely Republican Caucus participants say they "would definitely not support" him for the GOP nomination. Bush is next on this "no way" list with 23 percent, followed by New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie with 14 percent.

Republican Caucus-goers say 79 - 15 percent that experience outside of Washington is better for a president than Washington experience.

"The Iowa Republican Caucus looks like a two-man race in which the Washington experience that has traditionally been a major measuring stick that voters have used to choose candidates is now a big negative," said Peter A. Brown, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

"With five months until the balloting, anything can happen. But the field has become a two-tiered contest – Donald Trump and Ben Carson ahead and everyone else far behind."

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"Perhaps even more surprising, given the 17-member field of candidates vying for the Republican presidential nomination, is that more than half the votes in the Quinnipiac University poll of likely-GOP caucus-goers are going to three candidates who have never held political office – Donald Trump, Ben Carson and Carly Fiorina," Brown added.

Trump has a 60 - 35 percent favorability rating among likely Republican Caucus participants, as these voters say 56 - 35 percent that he is honest and trustworthy and 61 - 32 percent that he cares about their needs and problems. He has strong leadership qualities, voters say 83 - 15 percent, and the right temperament and personality to handle an international crisis, voters say 52 - 41 percent.

Carson gets a 79-6 percent favorability rating and likely Republican Caucus-goers say 88-4 percent that he is honest and trustworthy, and 85-5 percent that he cares about their needs and problems. Voters say 76-11 percent that he has strong leadership qualities and 72-14 percent that he has the right temperament and personality to handle an international crisis.

Iowa likely Republican Caucus participants give Cruz a 61 - 19 percent favorability rating. He is honest and trustworthy, voters say 69 - 16 percent and cares about their needs and problems, voters say 70 - 17 percent. He has strong leadership qualities, voters say 66 - 19 percent and the right temperament and personality for an international crisis, voters say 59 - 25 percent.

"Trump's 27 – 21 percent lead over Carson obscures what appears to be the former surgeon's stronger growth potential in recruiting new supporters when other candidates leave the race. Carson has a higher favorability rating than Trump and a higher score for honesty and empathy," said Brown. "Trump has an edge on leadership, but Carson has a 20-point margin when it comes to having the right temperament and personality to handle an international crisis."

From August 27 – September 8, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,038 likely Iowa Republican Caucus participants with a margin of error of +/- 3 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.

The Quinnipiac University Poll, directed by Douglas Schwartz, Ph.D., conducts public opinion surveys in Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Florida, Ohio, Virginia, Iowa, Colorado and the nation as a public service and for research.
