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CLINTON BACK ON TOP IN IOWA DEMOCRATIC CAUCUS, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; DEBATE VIEWERS SAY 2-1 CLINTON TOPPED SANDERS

Former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton is back on top among Iowa likely Democratic Caucus participants, with 51 percent, followed by Sen. Bernie Sanders of Vermont with 40 percent, according to a Quinnipiac University poll released today.

This compares to results of a September 10 survey by the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University showing Sanders at 41 percent, with Clinton at 40 percent.

Today, former Maryland Gov. Martin O'Malley gets 4 percent of Iowa likely Democratic Caucus participants, with no other candidate even scoring 1 percent and 4 percent undecided.

The wide gender gap among Democrats continues as Sanders leads Clinton 51 – 39 percent among men, while Clinton leads Sanders 59 – 33 percent among women.

Former U.S. Sen. Jim Webb jumps to the top of the negative list as 24 percent of likely Democratic Caucus-goers say they definitely would not vote for him, followed by former Rhode Island Gov. Lincoln Chafee at 21 percent.

Clinton and Sanders have similarly high favorability ratings, 82 – 16 percent for Clinton and 83 – 8 percent for Sanders.

“A strong debate performance doesn’t always translate into better poll numbers, but it sure did for Hillary Clinton. Likely Iowa Caucus participants who watched or listened to the debate scored it 2 – 1 for the former secretary of state,” said Peter A. Brown, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

“Clinton had been losing momentum among the key Iowa Caucus participants and last month was tied with Sen. Bernie Sanders, who seemed to have the momentum in Iowa and nationally. But the debate seemed to reverse that trend and once again she is the leader of the pack in Iowa,” Brown added.

Among the 48 percent of Iowa likely Democratic Caucus participants who watched or listened to last week's Democratic debate, 62 percent say Clinton did the best job, with 31 percent for Sanders and 3 percent for O'Malley.

Chafee did the worst job, 39 percent say, and 37 percent say Webb did worst.

Rating Clinton's personal qualities, Iowa Democrats say:

- 70 – 24 percent that she is honest and trustworthy;
- 92 – 7 percent that she has strong leadership qualities;
- 83 – 15 percent that she cares about their needs and problems;
- 92 – 7 percent that she has the right kind of experience to be president.

Rating Sanders, Democrats say:

- 87 – 5 percent that he is honest and trustworthy;
- 71 – 17 percent that he has strong leadership qualities;
- 86 – 7 percent that he cares about their needs and problems;
- 60 – 27 percent that he has the right kind of experience to be president.

From October 14 – 20, Quinnipiac University surveyed 592 likely Iowa Democratic Caucus participants with a margin of error of +/- 4 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.
