

NJ0813 Demographics

From August 1 - 5, 2013 Quinnipiac University surveyed 2,042 registered voters in New Jersey with a margin of error of +/- 2.17 percentage points. 388 Likely Democratic Primary Voters were surveyed with a margin of error of +/- 4.98 percentage points, and 257 Likely Republican Primary Voters were surveyed with a margin of error of +/- 6.11 percentage points.
