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# CUOMO THUMPS TRUMP, ASTORINO IN NEW YORK GOV RACE, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; CLINTON RUNS BETTER AGAINST CHRISTIE IN 2016 RACE

New York Gov. Andrew Cuomo has a 63 - 28 percent job approval rating, higher than the current scores for any governor in the nine states surveyed by Quinnipiac University, and tops either of two possible Republican challengers to his reelection by margins of more than 2-1, according to a poll released today.

Gov. Cuomo buries Donald Trump 63 – 26 percent and tops Westchester County Executive Rob Astorino 58 – 24 percent, the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University poll finds.

Cuomo deserves to be reelected, New York State voters say 59 - 31 percent. The governor gets 59 - 28 percent favorability rating, compared to negative 27 - 60 percent favorability for Trump. Astorino remains largely unknown as 86 percent of voters haven't heard enough about him to form an opinion.

The governor gets high grades on character traits as voters say:

- 75-21 percent that he has strong leadership qualities;
- 62 30 percent that he is honest and trustworthy;
- 51-42 percent that he cares about their needs and problems.

"Take your pick: Gov. Andrew Cuomo, an opponent nobody knows or an opponent

nobody likes. It comes out the same either way: Gov. Cuomo trounces Westchester County Executive Rob Astorino, the unknown, or Donald Trump, the unliked," said Maurice Carroll, director of the Quinnipiac University Polling Institute.

"New Yorkers think their governor does a good job and that he deserves a second term, and they say he scores high on all the standard traits that pollsters measure."

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New York State voters give Cuomo mixed grades on handling issues that usually pull down approval ratings for other governors: A split 45 - 43 percent job approval for handling taxes and a split 46 - 45 percent score for his handling of the economy and jobs.

Cuomo's positive grades include 52 - 31 percent approval for handling ethics in government and 49 - 32 percent approval for handling energy and the environment. By a narrower 44 - 39 percent, voters approve Cuomo's handling of gun policy.

New York State voters give the State Legislature a negative 28 - 57 percent job approval rating, but say 46 - 25 percent that their State Assembly member deserves reelection and 54 - 28 percent that their state senator deserves another shot.

In an early look at the 2016 presidential campaign, former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton tops New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie 58 – 31 percent, leading among all groups except Republicans.

Cuomo tops Christie 50 - 34 percent, with 79 - 11 percent support among Democrats. Republicans go to Christie 69 - 19 percent while independent voters are divided, with 39 percent for Cuomo and 38 percent for Christie. New York City voters back Cuomo 63 - 23 percent, while upstate voters are divided 40 - 39 percent and suburban voters go 46 percent for Cuomo and 42 percent for Christie.

"We're two years away from the New Hampshire Primary, but people will gossip about politics and for now New Yorkers put former Secretary of State – and former New York Senator – Hillary Clinton, and current Favorite Son Andrew Cuomo ahead of Christie," Carroll said.

#### President Obama, Sen. Schumer, Sen. Gillibrand Approval Ratings

New York State voters approve 52 - 44 percent of the job President Barack Obama is doing, compared to a negative 47 - 49 percent approval rating November 26.

Voters approve 61 – 24 percent of the job U.S. Sen. Charles Schumer is doing and give U.S. Sen. Kirsten Gillibrand a 58 – 19 percent approval rating.

"He's down in Quinnipiac University's national polls and polls of other states, but New Yorkers keep President Barack Obama above water in his approval ratings," Carroll said.

From February 6 – 10, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,488 New York State voters with a margin of error of +/-2.5 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.
