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NEW YORK CITY VOTERS DIVIDED ON PAYING FIRST LADY, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; VOTERS WANT MAYOR, COUNCIL TO HAVE EQUAL POWER

New York City voters approve 43 - 28 percent of the job First Lady Chirlane McCray is doing and are divided 46 - 45 percent on whether she should be paid for her city work, according to a Quinnipiac University Poll released today.

There is not much of a gender gap, but a substantial racial gap on whether Ms. McCray should be paid, the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University Poll finds. Men are split 45-47 percent on paying the First Lady, and women support paying her by a thin 48-43 percent. Support for paying McCray is 61-33 percent among black voters and 49-41 percent among Hispanic voters. White voters oppose paying her 57-35 percent.

New York City voters approve 48 - 38 percent of the job Mayor Bill de Blasio is doing, his lowest grade since a 45 - 46 percent approval rating in a January 18, 2017 survey.

Looking at the mayor's qualities, voters say:

- 50 39 percent that he is honest and trustworthy;
- 51-43 percent that he has strong leadership qualities;
- 50-42 percent the he understands their problems.

New York City voters approve 56 - 37 percent of the job Gov. Andrew Cuomo is doing and say 58 - 22 percent that he would be better for the city than Cynthia Nixon. Democrats say 64 - 21 percent that Cuomo would be better.

"New York City voters like First Lady Chirlane McCray, but they're apparently of mixed opinion about giving her a paycheck," said Tim Malloy, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

"Gov. Andrew Cuomo is much better for the city than his high profile challenger, Cynthia Nixon. Again, the governor has a higher job approval rating than Mayor Bill de Blasio.

"New Yorkers to Mayor de Blasio and Gov. Cuomo, 'Yeah, we know you don't get along, but knock it off for the good of the city."

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Gov. Cuomo and Mayor de Blasio are involved in a "personal feud" 47 percent of New York City voters say, while 40 percent believe they have "honest disagreements."

Either way, 60 percent of voters say the conflict hurts the city, while 9 percent say it helps the city and 25 percent say it makes no difference.

In this conflict, New York City voters agree more with Cuomo than de Blasio 38 - 32 percent. Democrats agree more with de Blasio 40 - 33 percent.

Mayor and City Council

The mayor and the New York City Council should have equal power governing the city, 71 percent of voters say, as 18 percent want the mayor to have more power and 7 percent want the City Council to have more power.

Voters approve 43 - 15 percent of the job newly elected City Council Speaker Corey Johnson is doing, an approval rating Melissa Mark-Viverito achieved only once in her four years as Council Speaker. Approval ratings for other citywide leaders are:

- 53 18 percent for Police Commissioner James O'Neill;
- 46 19 percent for Public Advocate Letitia James;
- 55 19 percent for City Comptroller Scott Stringer, close to his highest rating ever.

New York City voters disapprove 76 – 19 percent of the job President Donald Trump is doing.

Voters approve 52 - 37 percent of the way de Blasio is handling the Police Department, but he gets mixed or negative grades for handling other issues:

- A divided 43 46 percent for handling the public schools;
- 26 60 percent for handling public housing projects;
- 31 56 percent for handling affordable housing;
- Split 40 40 percent for handling taxes;
- 28-62 percent for handling poverty and homelessness.

From March 22 - 27, Quinnipiac University surveyed 955 New York City voters with a margin of error of ± 4.1 percentage points, including the design effect. Live interviewers call landlines and cell phones.

The Quinnipiac University Poll, directed by Douglas Schwartz, Ph.D., conducts nationwide public opinion surveys, and statewide polls in Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Florida, Ohio, Virginia, Iowa and Colorado as a public service and for research.
