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NATIVE SON KASICH BEST AGAINST CLINTON IN OHIO 2016, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY POLL FINDS; OBAMA STUCK DEEP IN VOTER APPROVAL QUICKSAND

Ohio Gov. John Kasich runs better against former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton than any other Republican in an early look at the 2016 presidential race in Ohio, but still trails the Democratic front-runner 47 – 42 percent, according to a Quinnipiac University poll released today.

This compares to Secretary Clinton's 51 – 39 percent lead over Gov. Kasich in a February 20 survey by the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University. Clinton leads other possible 2016 Republican contenders by margins of 7 to 14 percentage points:

- 48 39 percent over former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush;
- 47 40 percent over U.S. Sen. Marco Rubio of Florida;
- 49 41 percent over U.S. Sen. Rand Paul of Kentucky;
- 46 38 percent over N.J. Gov. Christopher Christie;
- 48 41 percent over U.S. Rep. Paul Ryan of Wisconsin;
- 51 37 percent over U.S. Sen. Ted Cruz of Texas;
- 49 41 percent over former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee.

"Gov. John Kasich runs best against Secretary Hillary Clinton for 2016 among eight Republican candidates, although her lead over most of them has dropped considerably since Quinnipiac University surveyed Ohio voters in February," said Peter A. Brown, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll. "Most of the GOP candidates are bunched together, trailing by high single digits in trial heats. Kasich's standing might seem logical given his home field advantage, but in February Kasich trailed Ms. Clinton by a dozen points and was down in the pack. Still Ms. Clinton has the best favorability rating of the group."

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By a 53 - 43 percent margin, Ohio voters have a favorable opinion of Clinton, compared to 47 - 29 percent for Kasich. Favorability ratings for other Republicans are:

- Negative 32 38 percent for Jeb Bush;
- 36 36 percent for Christie;
- 38 29 percent for Paul;
- 24 26 percent for Cruz;
- 37 31 percent for Huckabee;
- 39 30 percent for Ryan;
- 31 19 percent for Rubio.

President Obama Approval

Ohio voters give President Barack Obama a negative 39 - 58 percent approval rating, compared to a negative 40 - 55 percent score February 20.

Negative scores are 35-63 percent among men, 43-53 percent among women, 8-91 percent among Republicans and 34-63 percent among independent voters. Democrats approve 82-17 percent.

"President Barack Obama's job approval remains stuck at about 40 percent in Ohio. Although he is not on the ballot this November, such a consistently low rating can't be helpful to the Democratic ticket, especially gubernatorial nominee Ed Fitzgerald who currently trails Gov. Kasich 50 – 35 percent and is somewhat of an unknown to Ohio voters. If the president's numbers remain in the basement, look for Kasich's TV ads to tie Fitzgerald to the president," Brown said.

Ohio voters approve 49 - 33 percent of the job U.S. Sen. Sherrod Brown is doing and give U.S. Sen. Rob Portman a 44 - 27 percent approval rating.

From May 7 - 12, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,174 registered voters with a margin of error of ± 2.9 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.
