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NEW JERSEY GOV. CHRISTIE IS HOTTEST POLITICIAN IN U.S., QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY NATIONAL THERMOMETER FINDS; POPE HAS BIGGEST IMPACT ON OUR LIVES

New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie is the hottest politician in the nation, with a 55.5 degree mean temperature, when American voters rate their feelings toward players on the national political stage, according to a Quinnipiac University national thermometer released today.

Former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee is second hottest, with a 51 degree mean temperature (note that this is not a percentage) among all voters, and hottest among Republican voters, with a toasty 74.9 degree mean temperature. The independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University poll asks voters to rate their feelings from a cold of 0 degrees to 100 degrees.

Massachusetts Sen. Elizabeth Warren is third hottest, with a 50.7 degree mean temperature, but 46 percent of voters don't know enough about her to form an opinion.

There's a lot of warmth for Louisiana Gov. Bobby Jindal, Ohio Gov. John Kasich and Wisconsin Gov. Scott Walker, but in each case, more than 50 percent of voters have no opinion.

Former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton is seventh on the list, with a 48.5 degree mean score. She also is the hottest politician among Democratic voters, with a sizzling 77.2 degrees.

"He may not seem the warm and fuzzy type, but New Jersey Gov. Christopher Christie is a hot ticket in eyes of American voters," said Tim Malloy, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Polling Institute.

"A lot of would-be presidential candidates are struggling with a chilly reception from the voters, who either don't know them or don't warm to them. But the heat is on for Secretary Hillary Clinton, Gov. Christie and former Arkansas Gov. Mike Huckabee. When we ask about them among members of their own party, Clinton and Huckabee are near tropical while Christie is lukewarm."

Pope Francis' Impact

Turning from the political arena, 44 percent of American voters say Pope Francis I had the most impact on people's lives in 2013, followed by:

- 22 percent for former National Security Agency consultant Edward Snowden;
- 12 percent for Sen. Ted Cruz of Texas;
- 6 percent for Syrian President Bashar Assad;
- 2 percent for Edith Windsor, who won the U.S. Supreme Court case expanding rights for same-sex couples.

A total of 77 percent of American adults, including 89 percent of Catholics, have a “very favorable” or “favorable” opinion of Pope Francis. That includes 74 percent of Americans 18 to 29 years old and 71 percent of Americans who do not list themselves as members of a religion.

Americans say 57 – 22 percent, including 75 – 14 percent among Catholics and 49 – 26 percent among those who list no religion, that the Pope will attract more Catholics back to the church. Adults 18 to 29 years old agree 55 – 27 percent.

The Pope's statement that he can not judge gay people is a positive step, Americans say 70 – 21 percent. Agreement is 79 – 15 percent among Catholics, 62 – 28 percent among Protestants and 77 – 16 percent among those who list no religion.

From January 4 – 7, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,487 registered voters nationwide with a margin of error of +/- 2.5 percentage points. The survey of 1,757 adults has a margin of error of +/- 2.3 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.

The Quinnipiac University Poll, directed by Douglas Schwartz, Ph.D., conducts public opinion surveys in Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Florida, Ohio, Virginia, Iowa, Colorado and the nation as a public service and for research.
