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AMERICAN VOTERS BACK IRAN DEAL BY WIDE MARGIN, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY NATIONAL POLL FINDS; VOTERS OPPOSE FAITH EXCLUSION TO SERVE GAYS

American voters support 58 – 33 percent the preliminary agreement with Iran to restrict that country's nuclear program, according to a Quinnipiac University National poll released today.

At the same time, only 35 percent of voters are "very confident" or "somewhat confident" the agreement would prevent Iran from developing nuclear weapons, while 62 percent are "not so confident" or "not confident at all," the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University Poll finds.

Supporting the agreement are Democrats 76 - 15 percent and independent voters 60 - 33 percent, with Republicans opposed 56 - 37 percent.

The letter from Republican senators to Iranian leaders was <u>not</u> appropriate, American voters say 53 - 40 percent. It will hurt rather than help negotiations, voters say 37 - 8 percent, while 48 percent say it will make no difference.

Voters support 65 – 24 percent making any Iran agreement subject to congressional approval.

Voters back 77 – 13 percent a negotiated settlement rather than military intervention to limit Iran's nuclear program.

"Better to sit down and negotiate than to flex muscle and isolate. Americans are worried about Iran, but not enough to send in the troops," said Tim Malloy, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

American voters are divided on whether they will vote Democratic or Republican in the

2016 elections for the U.S. Senate and the House of Representatives:

- In House races, 40 percent would vote Republican, while 37 percent would vote Democratic;
- Voters in states where there is a U.S. Senate election are divided 39 39 percent on whether they would vote for a Democrat or a Republican.

Voters disapprove of Democrats in Congress less than they disapprove of Republicans, giving Democrats a negative 30 - 61 percent score, compared to a negative 22 - 69 percent for Republicans.

President Barack Obama gets a negative 44 - 49 percent job approval rating, continuing an upward climb from a negative 39 - 54 percent score in a November 25 Quinnipiac University poll.

Same-Sex Marriage

American voters support same-sex marriage 58 - 34 percent, with strong support from every party, gender and age group except Republicans, who are opposed 59 - 33 percent, and voters over 55 years old, who support same-sex marriage by a narrow 48 - 43 percent.

By a 69 - 26 percent margin, including a 50 - 44 percent margin among Republicans, voters say businesses should <u>not</u> be allowed to refuse service to gays and lesbians.

By a smaller 58 - 35 percent margin, voters say businesses should <u>not</u> be allowed to refuse service to gays and lesbians, even if it violates a business owner's religious beliefs.

Again, there is strong agreement among all groups except Republicans, who say 56 - 37 percent a business owner should be allowed to deny service based on religious belief.

"Americans support same-sex marriage by nearly 2-1, and by an even larger margin say businesses should not be allowed to discriminate against gays and lesbians," Malloy said.

From April 16 – 21, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,353 registered voters nationwide with a margin of error of +/-2.7 percentage points. Live interviewers call land lines and cell phones.
