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TRUMP GETS SMALL BUMP FROM AMERICAN VOTERS, QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY NATIONAL POLL FINDS; VOTERS WANT DEMOCRATS TO CONTROL HOUSE, SENATE

American voters give President Donald Trump a negative 40 - 55 percent job approval rating, his best score since a negative 40 - 56 percent approval rating April 19 after he launched a missile strike against Syria, according to a Quinnipiac University national poll released today.

Today's approval rating is up from a negative 34 – 57 percent score in a June 7 survey by the independent Quinnipiac (KWIN-uh-pe-ack) University. Over time, the approval rating fluctuates while the disapproval number remains fairly constant.

American voters say 63 - 34 percent that President Trump is <u>not</u> level-headed, an improvement from June 7 when voters said 68 - 29 percent that he is <u>not</u> level-headed, his worst grade on that quality. Voter opinions of most other Trump qualities are negative:

- 57 38 percent that he is <u>not</u> honest;
- 54 44 percent that he does <u>not</u> have good leadership skills;
- 55 44 percent that he does not care about average Americans;
- 63 34 percent that he is a strong person;
- 58 39 percent that he is intelligent;
- 59 38 percent that he does not share their values.

Voters say 52 - 46 percent that Trump is abusing the powers of his office.

Trump fired FBI Director James Comey to disrupt the FBI investigation into possible coordination between the Trump campaign and the Russian government, 54 percent of voters believe, while 39 percent say the president fired Comey because he lost confidence in him.

"A bump, not a jump, in approval for President Donald Trump, who is still mired in awful numbers on leadership, honesty and empathy," said Tim Malloy, assistant director of the Quinnipiac University Poll.

"Americans believe FBI Director James Comey was shown the door less for job performance than for the growing storm clouds from the FBI Russian investigation."

"The fact that voters consider Trump far more fact-challenged than Comey seems to back that up," Malloy added.

American voters are divided on whether Trump's decision to fire Comey was an abuse of power as 47 percent say it was and 49 percent say it was <u>not</u>.

Voters believe 54 - 32 percent reports that Trump asked Comey to drop the FBI investigation into former National Security Director Michael Flynn.

And voters trust Comey more than Trump 56 - 36 percent to tell the truth about important issues.

Trump has inappropriate financial ties to Russia, American voters say 48 – 43 percent.

The president did something illegal in his relationship with Russia, 28 percent of voters say, while 29 percent say he did something unethical but not illegal and 37 percent say he did nothing wrong.

Trump's Tweets

Trump should stop tweeting from his personal Twitter account, American voters say 61-32 percent. For the first time since the Quinnipiac University Poll asked this question, Republicans want the president to stop tweeting from his personal account, 49-43 percent.

Control of House and Senate

American voters say 51-41 percent that they would like to see the Democratic Party win control of the U.S. House of Representatives. Independent voters want Democratic control 49-37 percent.

Voters also say 51-41 percent they would like Democrats to control the U.S. Senate. Independent voters go Democratic 51-36 percent.


From June 22 - 27, Quinnipiac University surveyed 1,212 voters nationwide with a margin of error of +/- 3.4 percentage points, including the design effect. Live interviewers call landlines and cell phones.
